Richard Branson, DC - Dr. Branson earned his Doctor of Chiropractic in 1991 from Western States Chiropractic College in Portland, Ore. Since that time his wide-ranging experience includes private practice, serving as a staff clinician at the Institute for Athletic Medicine and as assistant professor of research at the Northwestern College of Chiropractic in Bloomington, Minn. Today he is director of chiropractic services at Fairview Health Services, a position he's held for the last 11 years and is chief chiropractic consultant for Blue Cross Blue Shield of Minnesota.



Jerome Craig, DC, LMT, CSCS, CKTP - Dr. Jerome Craig is an Oregon Board Certified Chiropractic Physician, Licensed Massage Therapist, Certified Strength and Conditioning Specialist (CSCS), and Certified Kinesio Tape Practitioner. An alumnus of WSCC, Dr. Craig continues his work in the chiropractic field by incorporating exercise, ART and various other soft tissue modalities, which he often bolsters and sustains with Kinesio Taping. He currently teaches Anatomy & Physiology to massage students at Western Sates University. Today he is the owner of Portland Chiropractic Care and Natural Health in the Kenton neighborhood of North Portland, an integrative health clinic, which provides massage, acupuncture, naturopathic and chiropractic medicine.



Elise G. Hewitt, DC, CST, DICCP, FICC - Dr. Hewitt is Board Certified in Chiropractic Pediatrics and Certified in Craniosacral Therapy through the Upledger Institute. An alumnus of the University of Colorado, she has been in private practice since graduating Summa Cum Laude from WSCC in 1988. In her pediatric practice, Dr. Hewitt specializes in the care of infants. Dr. Hewitt has been published in the scientific literature and is a co-author of the "Chiropractic" chapter in *Integrative Pediatric Medicine*, part of Andrew Weil's Integrative Medicine textbook series. She has served on the steering committees for several large-scale studies conducted in the field of pediatric integrative medicine. Dr. Hewitt frequently lectures nationwide, educating chiropractors about the finer points of pediatrics, and pediatricians and other allied practitioners about the role of chiropractic in pediatric healthcare. Dr. Hewitt currently serves as president of the American Chiropractic Association's (ACA) Pediatrics Council. She is a founding member of both the ACA Pediatrics Council and the Pediatrics Council of the International Chiropractors Association (ICA). In recognition of her service and achievement, Dr. Hewitt has been elected as a Fellow into the International College of Chiropractors (FICC). Craig Kawaoka, DC, DACBSP®, CSCS - Craig Kawaoka, DC, DACBSP, CSCS is currently Clinical Director of the MS in the Exercise and Sports Science Program at the University of Western States and formerly the Interim Director of Sports Medicine Residency and Assistant Professor at SCUHS. Dr Kawaoka has his Diplomate from the American Chiropractic Board of Sports Physician as well as being a Certified Strength and Conditioning Specialist. He has been a Team Doctor, Medical director or Medical staff for various organizations and events ranging from amateur, collegiate and high school, athletics, which has include Extreme Action Sports Tours, United States Weightlifting team. Dr Kawaoka has done preclinical and post graduate lectures centering on sports medicine.



Sara Mathov, DC, DACBR - Dr. Sara Mathov is faculty member within the diagnostic imaging department at University of Western States. She completed her chiropractic schooling at Northwestern Health Sciences University in Bloomington, MN in 2003. Shortly thereafter she packed up her belongings and moved to southern California to begin her residency training in diagnostic imaging at Southern California University of Health Sciences. She completed the residency in December, 2006 and immediately began teaching full-time within the radiology department there. She joined the University of Western States faculty in January, 2008 and has thoroughly enjoyed her teaching experience there. In addition, Dr. Mathov has a private radiology consulting practice. Prior to beginning her chiropractic schooling, she received a degree in Health and Human Development from Montana State University and became a certified athletic trainer. She worked as an athletic trainer throughout her chiropractic schooling and loves being on the sidelines of any event, but is especially fond of both football and ice hockey.



William Moreau, DC, DACBSP®, CSCS, FICC - Dr. Moreau is the Director of Sports Medicine Clinics for the United States Olympic Committee where he leads the multiple disciplinary sports medicine teams at all three Olympic Training Centers. He is also the founder and educational coordinator for DOnline. Dr. Moreau specializes in chiropractic sports medicine. He presents in the University of Western States DACBSP and CCSP Program. Dr. Moreau is a national recognized speaker who has presented over 275 postgraduate presentations across the United States and internationally. He works with Olympic, collegiate, high school and recreational athletes for over 25 years. Dr. Moreau also provides testimony for chiropractic malpractice cases. Dr. Moreau published scholarly works with an emphasis on concussion injury and athletics. He serves on the editorial board of the *Journal Chiropractic Medicine*, was an associate editor for the *Journal of Sports Chiropractic and Rehabilitation* for seven years. Dr. Moreau has served for 10 years on the American Chiropractic Board of Sports Physicians as president, a member of the board of directors.



Alex Vasquez, DC, ND - Dr. Vasquez began his professional training at Texas Chiropractic College and later graduated from Western States Chiropractic College in Portland, Oregon. He then attended and graduated from the Naturopathic Medicine Program at Bastyr University near Seattle, Washington. The next few years, Dr Vasquez maintained a private practice (in Seattle, then Houston, Texas), taught Orthopedics and Rheumatology at Bastyr University, and pursued his constant review of Medline for the continuous compilation of his biomedicine, nutrition, and physiology database. Dr Vasquez has published more than 70 articles and letters in magazines, newspapers, and peer-reviewed journals including *Alternative Therapies in Health and Medicine*, *JAMA*, *The Lancet*, *British Medical Journal*, *Annals of Pharmacotherapy*, *Journal of the American Osteopathic Association*, *Integrative Medicine*, *Evidence-based Complementary and Alternative Medicine*, *Journal of Clinical Endocrinology and Metabolism*, and *Arthritis & Rheumatism*--official journal of the American College of Rheumatology. Dr Vasquez has written four textbooks: [Integrative Orthopedics](#), [Integrative Rheumatology](#), [Musculoskeletal Pain: Expanded Clinical Strategies](#), [Chiropractic and Naturopathic Mastery of Common Clinical Disorders](#), and [Chiropractic Management of Chronic Hypertension](#). Dr Vasquez's current affiliations include National University of Health Sciences (Adjunct Professor), Institute for Functional Medicine (Forum Consultant), and Biotics Research Corporation (Researcher & Lecturer). He is currently a medical student at University of N.Texas Health Science Center Texas College of Osteopathic Medicine where he will graduate in 2010 as Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine.
